

Primary Care Pediatric Clinician-Investigator

The Department of Pediatric & Adolescent Medicine at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN, is seeking a pediatric clinician-investigator to join its primary care pediatric practice.

The primary care practice consists of 20 physicians and 7 nurse-practitioners, who comprise the Division of Community Pediatric and Adolescent Medicine, one of 17 divisions in the Department of Pediatric and Adolescent Medicine at Mayo Clinic. The division is an integral member of the Employee and Community Health initiative at Mayo Clinic and is leading the care for infants, children, and adolescents within the Rochester community with an innovative focus on team-based care models for population health.

The division is seeking an individual who has either already established a career in investigation of population health management and healthcare redesign or who seeks to obtain the training and mentorship necessary to establish an independent research program. Individuals seeking this position should demonstrate a commitment to pediatric research as well as skill in both collaboration and leadership. Responsibilities will include, in addition to the research, direct patient care with opportunities for precepting first and second-year medical students from the Mayo Medical School, and teaching and supervising our 38-member three-year pediatric residency.
