The Division of Pharmacoepidemiology and Pharmacoconomics is a 50-member interdisciplinary research program based in the Department of Medicine of Brigham and Women's Hospital and Harvard Medical School. Our work focuses on the evaluation, regulation, use, outcomes, and cost-effectiveness of prescription drugs and medical devices, as well as on the development and evaluation of innovative programs to improve prescribing and utilization.

We are seeking faculty and trainees at all levels as well as staff scientists to work with us in the above areas. We are also recruiting Deputy Directors to assist in managing programs on comparative effectiveness, medication adherence, and evidence-based prescribing.

For faculty, fellow, and post-doctoral candidates, doctoral-level training is required in medicine, epidemiology, statistics, computer science, law, pharmacy, or other relevant discipline. For faculty candidates, academic rank at Harvard Medical School at the Instructor or Assistant Professor level will be commensurate with experience, training and achievements.
