

# ASSOCIATE/FULL PROFESSOR

## University of California, Davis, School of Medicine Department of Internal Medicine

The Department of Internal Medicine, at the University of California, Davis, School of Medicine, is recruiting for a full-time academic position at the Associate or Full Professor level. The successful candidate (who may have clinical interests in general internal medicine or any subspecialty) will be a leader of a patient centered outcomes research group that will work closely with other faculty and groups to advance scholarship and practice related to healthcare access, quality, costs, or delivery. Appointees to this series are required to participate in teaching, research, University/public service and patient care. The selected candidate will be expected to work closely with faculty within the Division of General Medicine, across Divisions in the Department of Internal Medicine, and in related Centers including the Center for Healthcare Policy and Research, the Clinical and Translational Sciences Center, and the Betty Irene Moore School of Nursing. The candidate's research focus may be in health services, clinical epidemiology, comparative effectiveness, or outcomes. Clinical activities will include precepting in both inpatient and outpatient settings, where he/she will supervise and teach medical students and Internal Medicine residents.

Candidates must possess an M.D. degree plus an MPH, MS, or PhD in epidemiology, health services research, or one of the social sciences. Candidates must be board certified in Internal Medicine and be eligible for licensure in the state of California. Experience teaching medical students, residents and fellows is required. Evidence of success in obtaining NIH funding is required and current NIH funding is highly desirable. The ability to work cooperatively and collegially within a diverse environment is required.
