

**DIRECTOR, DIVISION OF GENERAL INTERNAL MEDICINE, MetroHealth System

The Department of Medicine of the MetroHealth System (MHS), a principal teaching hospital of the Case Western Reserve University (CWRU) School of Medicine, is inviting applications at the Associate/Full Professor rank for Director of the Division of General Internal Medicine. MHS is a fully integrated provider of high quality healthcare regardless of the patient's ability to pay. The System consists of the 731-bed MetroHealth Medical Center and 14 additional inpatient and outpatient facilities throughout Cuyahoga County, located in northern Ohio, including two long-term skilled nursing centers.

For this position, the incoming Division Director will lead programs that further the tradition of excellence in research, teaching, and patient care within the Division of General Internal Medicine. The successful candidate will be responsible for ensuring outstanding primary care for patients of northern Ohio and for continuing to lead in the education of medical students and internal medicine residents. Moreover, he/she will be expected to further develop the strong programs of independent and collaborative research within the Division and play an integral role in the CWRU-MetroHealth Center for Health Care Research and Policy (www.chrp.org) based at MetroHealth. The new Director also will have the opportunity to collaborate with researchers in the CWRU Center for Reducing Health Disparities (www.reducedisparity.org), also based at MetroHealth, and with strong MetroHealth campus programs in Heart and Vascular Diseases, Kidney Disease, and other specialties, as well as with the Cleveland Clinical Translational Sciences Collaborative (CTSC).

Qualified applicants should hold an MD, MD/PhD, or equivalent degree and must be Board-certified in Internal Medicine, have a record of productive funded research, be eligible for employment in the United States and eligible for an Ohio medical license. The successful candidate will have demonstrated experience in building programs and faculty recruitment. Academic rank and compensation will be commensurate with experience and achievement.
