



## LEADER FOR NEW INNOVATIONS AND OUTCOMES CENTER AT NYU LANGONE MEDICAL CENTER

NYU Langone Medical Center (NYULMC) seeks to recruit a **Director** to lead a **new Center for Healthcare Innovations and Health Outcomes**.

**The Center's overarching goal will be to advance and evaluate the impact of innovations in healthcare delivery designed to improve quality, health outcomes and efficiency both at NYULMC and in complex health care delivery systems more generally.** The initiative will integrate vital research and operational agendas, advancing key institutional priorities and population-health oriented care delivery strategies while addressing challenges common to systems across the nation.

Our new Department of Population Health (<http://pophealth.med.nyu.edu/>) will be the Center's academic home, and the Director will report to the Department Chair and NYULMC's delivery system leadership. NYULMC, with its dynamic environment of excellence, innovation and growth, encompasses NYU School of Medicine, three hospitals (Tisch Hospital, Rusk Institute of Rehabilitation Medicine, and the NYU Hospital for Joint Diseases) and a rapidly expanding clinically integrated network of ambulatory care.

The Center will bridge NYULMC's academic depth in health services research with the operational expertise and clinical agility of the delivery system itself; foster the evolution of the delivery system as "learning machine" by operationalizing innovative analytic and IT strategies in care delivery models; and advance extramurally-funded research, policy and healthcare management initiatives.

Core qualifications include: excellent record of quality scholarship and extramural funding as PI as well as proven leadership ability in health care delivery settings. MD degree preferred.
