All areas of research relevant to general internal medicine are welcome, including health services research, quality improvement, patient safety, health disparities, mental health, chronic illness management, patient-centered care, comparative effectiveness, informatics, clinical epidemiology, health policy, and public health.

PVAMC is a 240-bed tertiary acute and chronic care hospital and referral center for VISN 20 in the VA system, which includes Oregon, Idaho, Washington and Alaska. PVAMC is also the major affiliate teaching and research hospital for Oregon Health & Science University. Hired physicians will join a dynamic, collaborative group of clinicians, educators and researchers, and will be included as core investigators in a multidisciplinary VA HSR&D research center.
