

Academic Quality Improvement/General Pediatric Position in the Division of General Pediatrics, Department of Pediatrics, University of Utah

The Division of General Pediatrics in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Utah School of Medicine is recruiting for a full-time academic general pediatrician to share in the leadership of well-established and expanding programs in clinical quality improvement in primary and subspecialty care. The successful candidate will join the growing team of pediatricians boarded in pediatrics, developmental/behavioral and neurodevelopmental disabilities who comprise the Division of General Pediatrics. Responsibilities will include primary care clinical services and co-direction of the Utah Pediatric Partnership to Improve Healthcare Quality (UPIQ, upiq.org), a state-wide QI organization housed in the Division, and several evolving long-term QI projects/programs with a particular focus on children with chronic and complex conditions. Additional expectations include participation in resident and medical student education, involvement in collaborative research in the Division/Department, administration, and advocacy.

Qualified candidates must have an M.D. or D.O. degree, be BE/BC in General Pediatrics and have excellent clinical, leadership and research skills. The selected candidate will receive a faculty appointment in the Department of Pediatrics on the Clinical or Tenure track at the academic level commensurate with experience and qualifications.
