The Department seeks a dynamic Chief for our new Division of Health Systems Innovation and Implementation Science. The Division will focus on the development, implementation, and evaluation of patient-centered clinical innovations within the Weill Cornell Medical College/New York Presbyterian Hospital system and, as appropriate, in regional and national settings. Innovations should focus on improving the value of healthcare delivery. For example, innovations might focus on discrete quality improvement/patient safety initiatives such as medication clinical decision support, on improving care coordination such as reducing readmissions and ambulatory care sensitive admissions, and/or on population health such as organizing an accountable care organization. Clinical knowledge is required. Additional training in quality improvement, operations research, engineering, informatics, and/or a related field is desirable.

Candidates should be Associate or full Professors and have an outstanding record of introducing innovations, obtaining funding, and publishing research results. The ideal candidate will have the skills to collaborate productively with leaders in the Medical College, the Weill Cornell Physician Organization, and New York Presbyterian Hospital. Opportunities will also be available to collaborate with faculty at Cornell University and at the new Cornell Tech campus.
