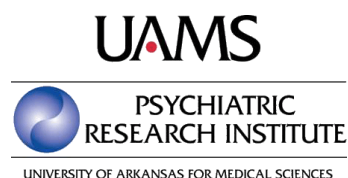

The Division of Health Services Research (DHSR) is seeking a Psychiatry/Health Services Research Physician to join our highly motivated research team. DHSR is one of four research divisions in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, and an integral component of the Psychiatric Research Institute. For two decades, DHSR has been recognized as one of the largest, most comprehensive, and innovative health services research centers in the nation. Since 1990, DHSR faculty has been awarded over \$80 million in extramural grants. DHSR is also the academic home to five nationally recognized VA-funded health services research centers and two post-doctoral research training programs.

DHSR is looking for a board eligible/board certified psychiatrist who will work with highly motivated staff to expand its portfolio of federally funded research. Research interests should be compatible with DHSR's mission to improve the lives of individuals with mental health and substance use disorders by conducting scientifically rigorous research in close partnership with clinical and community stakeholders.

The successful candidate will have the ability or potential to effectively lead research teams and to collaborate with investigators across a wide range of disciplines. An active program of scholarship and publication is essential. For more senior scholars a track record of externally funded research and for more junior scholars, clear potential and prospects for attracting extramural funding are important. The responsibilities for this position will include 50% research and 50% clinical duties. A full-time, non-tenure or tenure-track position is available and includes the opportunity for a joint appointment within our VA-funded research centers. Faculty rank and compensation will be commensurate with experience. All inquiries will be handled in strict confidence and should be accompanied by a CV and a letter of inquiry.
