Job Description:

- Develops, organizes, coordinates, and manages performance improvement projects in the ambulatory settings of the department of medicine.
- Acts as the DOM liaison in achieving regulatory and organizational compliance for performance improvement activities.
- Functions as the department expert for Medicare and Medicaid Member Initiatives, QI reporting and QI program development for new lines of business.
- Applies quality improvement processes and tools, including lean six sigma and continuous quality improvement as part of QI initiative planning, development and implementation.
- Develops, implements, and evaluates systems for collecting data and evaluating care outcomes.
- Acts as QI liaison for the Department of Medicine with internal and external customers at committee meetings and workgroups.
- Leads programs aimed at improving healthcare quality, reducing cost, improving access to care, and creating efficiency.
- Develops and implements QI staff training.
- Aligns QI activities with DOM strategic objectives.

Requirements:

- MD degree.
- Board Certification in Internal Medicine.
- Master's Degree in Health Administration or equivalent preferred but not required.
- Experience in quality improvement work.
- Knowledge of Continuous Quality Improvement, Lean, Six Sigma, National Committee of Quality Assurance (NCQA), Medicare Advantage, STARS, Maryland Value Based Purchasing (VBP), Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS), Consumer Assessment of Healthcare providers and Systems (CAHPS), COMAR, ERISA and Tricare/DOD.
- Ability to research, understand and communicate processes, tools and principles of quality improvement and change management.
- Leadership skills to gain cooperation of different parties to QI initiatives.
