

Call for proposals for the Harold Amos Medical Faculty Development Program (AMFDP)

The deadline for application is **March 15, 2017**.

Supported by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation—and a desire to build a [Culture of Health](#) in America—the Harold Amos Medical Faculty Development program acts on the belief that an ever-changing health care landscape requires capable, diverse leadership. **Applications are now open and due March 15, 2017.**

This program works to increase diversity among medical, nursing, and dentistry faculty. Up to 10 selected program scholars are eligible for:

- A four-year postdoctoral award of up to \$420,000
- An annual stipend of \$75,000
- An annual grant of \$30,000 to support research
- Additional awards available through partnership organizations

We are seeking applicants from “historically disadvantaged backgrounds,” which refers to challenges individuals may have faced because of their race, ethnicity, socioeconomic status, physical, learning or other disability, or who are first-generation college graduates. We also strongly encourage those who meet these criteria and are in the nursing and dentistry fields to apply. Please consider applying, or spread the word among your networks!
