Providing more than 25 years of service, the Tomsich Pathology Laboratories touch virtually every patient in the Cleveland Clinic System and thousands of patients across the world. The Institute is often rated as one of the busiest laboratories in the country with approximately 1,500 dedicated employees and more than 21 million tests processed annually that serve patients at Cleveland Clinic, Cleveland Clinic Family Health Centers, Cleveland Clinic Affiliated Hospitals, and more widely through Cleveland Clinic Laboratories.

The Robert J. Tomsich Pathology & Laboratory Medicine Institute has about 90 physicians in 15 subspecialty surgical pathology areas within the Department of Pathology and 6 unique specialty areas within the Department of Laboratory Medicine. The Institute also provides extraordinarily comprehensive and extensive experience in research and knowledge development.
