The Program Director will also manage and provide technical oversight for NQF consensus projects, workshops, and other "core" organizational and administrative work/tasks. A Master's Degree in a related field (i.e. MPH, MSHA, MHA, MS) or Healthcare Professional (i.e. RN, NP, PA, MD) is required. Strong knowledge of the healthcare delivery system and/or public health experience preferred. The ability to manage multiple projects and competing priorities is essential. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills required as well as the ability to interact effectively with a variety of people and work well on a team. Experience in one or more areas such as outcome and efficiency measures and measurement, episodes of care, treatment effectiveness, quality measurement and/or risk adjustment methodology are a plus.
