The Ambulatory and Hospital Care Statistics Branch, Division of Health Care Statistics, National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS), is seeking a physician for a service fellowship. The Branch conducts nationally-representative surveys of office-based physicians and hospital emergency, outpatient, and inpatient departments that collect data about clinicians and organizations, their patients, and management of patients' conditions. Policymakers and researchers use these data to analyze patterns and management of specific conditions, quality of care and disparities among populations, diffusion of medical technology, use of resources for specific conditions, and effects of policy changes.

The Service Fellow will conduct research to analyze these data and participate in survey operations, including the addition of free-standing ambulatory surgery centers into the National Hospital Ambulatory Medical Care Survey (NHAMCS). The Service Fellow will provide medical expertise on a wide range of topics, prepare high-quality written materials, and collaborate with other staff members.

Applicants should have an M.D. or D.O. degree; strong analytical skills; and substantial post-residency training or experience in health services research, statistics, economics, epidemiology, medical informatics, sociology, or a related field. Experience in basic survey methods is highly desirable. Ability to use SAS, Stata, or other analytic software is a plus. Salary commensurate with education and experience. A salary range of \$73,100–\$113,007 is expected, with the possibility of up to an additional 25% as a Physician's Comparability Allowance. Arrangements may be made for continuing clinical practice.

U.S. citizenship or legal permanent residence with work authorization is required. NCHS, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, is an equal opportunity employer.
