The MGH Center for Child and Adolescent Health Policy is seeking two faculty: a **Pediatric Clinical/Health Services Clinician–Investigator** and a **Pediatric Research Scientist (Social or Behavioral)** to join its research programs. Each position includes a tenure-line faculty appointment at Harvard Medical School. The center carries out multidisciplinary research in child and adolescent health services, outcomes, and health policy ([massgeneral.org/children/ccahp](http://massgeneral.org/children/ccahp)). The center includes 12 MD and PhD researchers with a support staff of programmers, research assistants, and administrative assistants.

**Pediatric Clinical/Health Services Clinician–Investigator.** We seek a clinician-investigator to help direct the activities of the MGH Center for Child and Adolescent Health Policy and expand existing research programs. **Pediatric Research Scientist (Social or Behavioral).** We seek a social or behavioral scientist to contribute expertise to new and existing research programs and collaborate with other faculty members on applications for new funding. Candidates must have a PhD, ScD, or DrPH in an appropriate field (e.g., economics, health services, sociology, developmental psychology, public health) and a proven track record of publications and externally-funded research in areas related to child health. The **MGH Center for Child and Adolescent Health Policy** is dedicated to improving the health of children and adolescents through research that identifies and promotes effective programs and policies for their health care. The Center has close ties with investigators in the Partners Institute for Health Policy and the Harvard School of Public Health. It also serves as the MGH site for the Harvard-wide Child Health Services Research Fellowship. Major current research includes work examining the evidence base for elements of care for children with chronic health conditions (support: Maternal and Child Health Bureau), several studies related to preventing secondhand smoke exposure by children (NIH, RWJ Fdn., FAMRI), development of a national multisite program of intervention research in childhood autism (Autism Speaks and MCHB), and research on the impact of childhood chronic illness and quality of life (CDC, Autism Speaks, NIH), and benefits for employees with children with chronic health conditions.
