The PRC is the hub of research activities within the Division of Prevention and Populations Sciences in the Department of Pediatrics and enjoys strong collaborative ties with other departments in the School of Medicine and with the College of Nursing and College of Pharmacy.

The successful candidate would be eligible for appointment in the Department of Pediatrics. Joint appointments with other departments will also be considered. Currently there are more than 36 funded projects carried out by 6 faculty, 70 staff, fellows, and students. The PRC belongs to a network of 35 centers across the nation funded by Centers of Disease Prevention and Control (CDC).
