### **Researcher/Associate Director**

The Public Citizen Health Research Group has a track record in, and commitment to, research-based consumer health advocacy with a particular focus on the safety and efficacy of drugs, devices, and health care services. The Researcher/ Associate Director will have primary responsibility for leadership and management of a variety of projects and assist the Director in overseeing the work of the Health Research Group. This full-time position will be based at Public Citizen's headquarters in Washington, DC.

An MD with a completed residency in internal medicine or family medicine is required. Additional training in public health or preventive medicine would be useful. Other essential requirements include strong analytical and methodological capabilities, good writing skills, a record of published research articles, and proven managerial skills. The latter should include an ability to plan, supervise, and monitor projects and allocate resources; mentor junior researchers; and supervise a small staff. Past experience in the area of drugs and devices is a plus, as is the ability to deal with news media and respond quickly to fast-moving events. Person should be an imaginative self-starter with a willingness to tackle sensitive health policy issues.
